# Maine Journeyman-In-Training Electrician

A Journeyman-in-Training Electrician is a person making electrical installations in the employment of a master electrician, limited electrician or electrical company and under the supervision of a journeyman, limited or master electrician. A Journeyman-in-Training must be a graduate of an accredited Maine technical college or Department of Corrections electrical program, receive a passing grade on the journeyman examination and complete 2,000 hours of experience.

- In order to qualify for a Journeyman-in-training electricians license, a person must be a graduate of an accredited vocational technical college electrical program, receive a passing grade on the journeyman's examination, complete 2,000 hours of experience and provide notarized documentation from the applicant's employer(s) verifying 2000 hours of
  - working experience as an electrician.
